Clerk's highlights from the Church Committee meeting held December 9, 2025 -



- Treasurer's report - October and November reports were available. October's expenses were \$28,805.89. Income was \$29,508.02. Surplus for October was \$702.13; deficit year-to-date was \$15,447.24. Per Sue Larsen, October was an uneventful month. November's expenses were \$36,493.42. Income was \$57,095.00. The increase in income was due in part to receiving \$17,000 from the Trust fund to help cover expenses. Bills for the floor will appear in the December report. Surplus for the month of November is \$20,601.58; surplus year-to-date is \$5,154.34.
- Investments - Sue Larsen has not seen an investment report from Kingston Wealth Management yet, nor has Jean Trotman.
- The next meeting will be the Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 18, 2026 following the morning service; time is 11:30 am; in person and via Zoom. The Diaconate will provide a light lunch for those attending. We encourage everyone to attend as we need a quorum of 25 to approve reports, the nominating slate, and the operating budget for 2026. Inclement weather date is January 25, 2026.




## *Pre-Thanksgiving Interfaith Service*
